Re: Learning Center Tutoring Programs - **Registration**

Registration for the Learning Center has begun. You may fill out the attached form then bring the City identification cards for your family and cash or a check for the fees to the Library or you can do all that on Back to School Night on Thursday, August 20, 2009 on the plaza. You can register your children for:

- **K-12 Targeted Tutoring**

This program is for children requiring specific tutoring by a credentialed teacher in a specific subject like Math or Reading. As before, the schedule will be Monday and Wednesday from 3 p.m. to 6 p.m. for K through 5<sup>th</sup> grade and Tuesday and Thursday from 4 p.m. until 6 p.m. for 6<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade.

- **Homework Help**

This program is for assistance with any assigned homework from a qualified volunteer and will be open on Monday and Wednesday from 3 p.m. until 6 p.m. and Tuesday and Thursday from 4 p.m. until 6 p.m. Any child or teenager may come in at any time during those hours for help.

- **High School Exit Exam - Suspended indefinitely**

- **At Risk of Retention, Resource Specialist Program (RSP) – NO FEE**

Registration for the At Risk of Retention and Resource Specialist Program (RSP) Program requires a review by the City Librarian of the child's latest report card and a letter from the teacher on school letterhead stating that the child is in danger of failing the grade or a copy of the child's current Resource Specialist Program. Once the child is accepted in the program you may register at the Jones Reading and Math Clinic in Covina.
